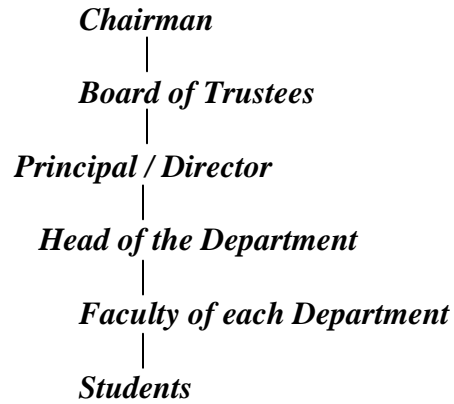

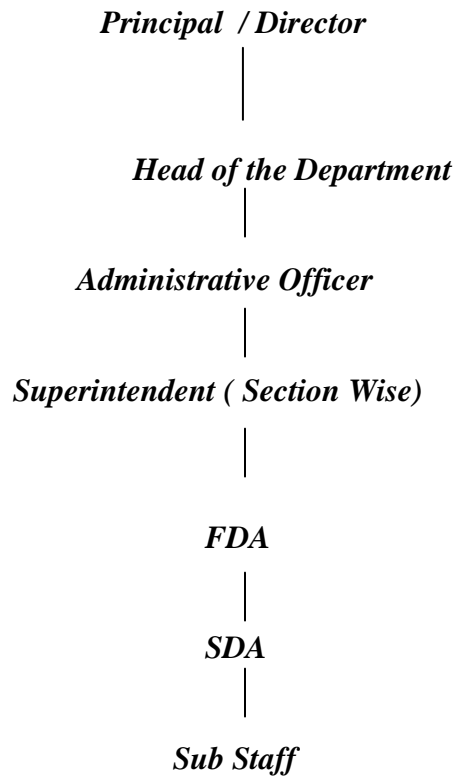

- ❖ Nature and Extent of involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs/ improvements:

*The department has a department consultative committee with Director as Chairman, 4 specialization heads and 3 students act as members of DCC The Committee decides on the annual calendar of events. Experts to be invited for delivering for guest lectures, specialized management topics/soft skill programmes, and any such academic activities. The DCC also reviews semester wise results and remedial / support measures are planned and executed.*

They interact with HRD's of various industries & explore the feasibility of entering into MOUs with them.*
