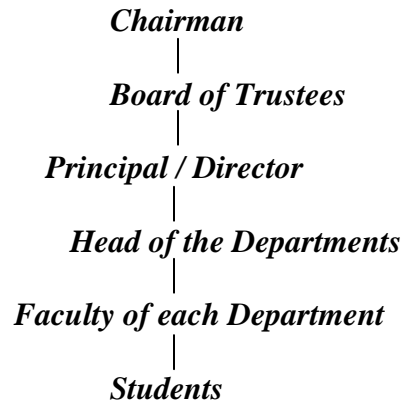

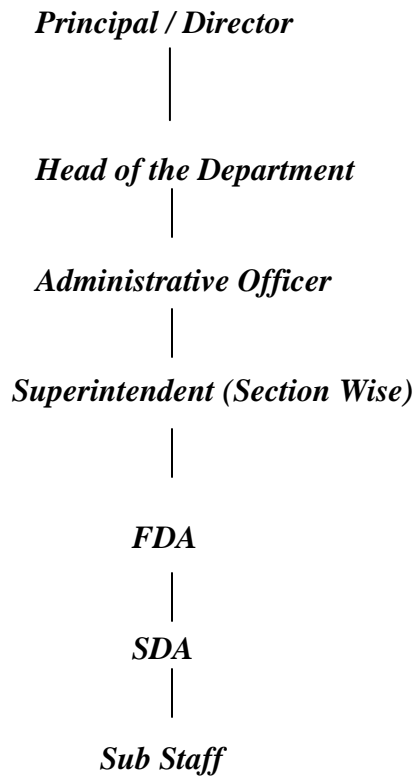

- ❖ Nature and Extent of involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs/ improvements:

The department has a department consultative committee with Director as Chairman, 4 specialization heads and 3 students act as members of DCC The Committee decides on the annual calendar of events. Experts to be invited for delivering for guest lectures, specialized management topics/soft skill programmes, etc, and any such academic activities. The DCC also reviews semester wise results and remedial / support measures are planned and executed.

Placement & Training Committee: They explore & arrange for the 2-4 weeks of industrial training during vacation periods. They also arrange for industrial projects for MBA students, provide summer placements and finally placing the students on jobs. They interact with HRD's of various industries & explore the feasibility of entering into MOUs with them

Library Committee: will advice on the procurement of books in the fields of interest catering to academic needs of students & staff of the department. Procurement of Journals /CD/s /Video programmes on management / Role playing games, case studies etc.

The faculty members are encouraged to attend conference, seminars symposium, faculty development programmes,AICTE sponsored ISTE STTP's, to seek admission for the Ph.D programmes under QIP. In addition, training modules are prepared to train the young teachers to get updated with the additional knowledge.

Student Development Programmes:

In addition to the regular university prescribed academic programmes students are encouraged to participate in management related seminars & conferences, management festivals. They are encouraged to make visits to industries in & around Bangalore and get an exposure to live situations & enable them to solve live problems & submit a report to both industry & institute. They are motivated to involve in role playing activities and are encouraged to practice case sessions in mock board room meetings.

❖ Student Feedback on Institutional Governance/faculty performance

The institution is governed by (i) A Governing body and (ii) An advisory council body. Both of the bodies formulate policies governing the college, its staff and students, formulates and regulates the norms and procedures to be followed in terms of admissions, fee structure, discipline etc. The bodies meet every 3-4 months and address itself to various requirements of students, staff & College. As all decisions are taken on the basis of well being of students, there is no practice of any feed back being taken on the governance of the college from students.

However, at the end of every semester the students are asked to give a feed back on the performance of the teacher individually. This would be analyzed and the teacher's performance is reviewed by the concerned authorities and with their recommendation the review is further subjected to scrutiny by the governing body chairman & appropriate action will be taken.

- ❖ Grievance redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students

The aggrieved students, staff & faculty are allowed to appeal to the principal through the concerned Head of the Department. The HOD, in turn, will submit them for further review by the principal who places it before the grievance committee. This committee takes a decision on the aggrieved matter. While the grievance committee for students will have 2 student representatives on the body and that G.C. for staff & faculty will have 2 representatives each.
